Recommended Action	Administration recommends that the Governing Board approve the multi-term contract renewal for September 2018.
Goals	Strategic Goal 2: We will ensure resources meet the current and future needs of our students.

Public Content

District multi-year contracts (RFPs & IFBs) are renewed annually and are designated as "Contract Renewals" that were originally awarded by the Governing Board. These contracts require approval by the Governing Board in order to extend for another contract term. All vendors have provided satisfactory service during the term of their contract. Most vendors kept their pricing the same as was offered in the previous year. This recommendation is in compliance with the School District Procurement Rules. It is in the District's best interest to approve the recommended contract renewal. The awarded vendors provide arts & craft supplies and related materials to Tempe Union High School District and participating cooperative entities Greater Phoenix Purchasing Consortium of Schools (GPPCS) and Strategic Alliance for Volume Expenditures (SAVE). The goods and services are provided as a market basket pricing structure based on a percentage off discount from published catalogs and walk-in retail store discounts. All vendors have agreed to hold their original pricing.

In order to ensure continuity in payment of ongoing expenses, the Governing Board is asked to authorize administration to proceed with a contract renewal with these vendors. Expenditures with some of these vendors will most likely exceed \$100,000.
